## *Hebe The Gemstone Series*

All the plants in this series were raised in 2008 and have been tested for hardiness and diseases in a garden in North Hampshire in the UK. Hebes will succeed in all types of well-drained soil.

*Hebe White Quartz (4000 plugs available April 2018)*



An ideal plant for ground cover both for the home gardener, landscapers and the amenity market for industrial planting

*Hebe White Quartz* is nearly completely flat 150 x 150cm wide and 20cm high (after 9 years)

The leaves are glaucous silver blue. In July and August the white flowers completely cover the shrub that are loved by bees

*Hebe Purple Quartz (4000 plugs available April 2018)*



Another ideal plant for ground cover both for the home gardener, landscapers and the amenity market for industrial planting. This cultivar is a stronger more diseases free form of *Hebe* 'Mrs Winder'.

110cm x 40 cm high, a very attractive plant throughout the year (this top photo taken in the winter)

And in the summer small blue flowers cover the bush, that are loved by bees

*Hebe Lilac Quartz* (4000 plugs available April 2018)



This is a beauty, a hardier and more compact form of *Hebe* 'Midsummer Beauty', 100cm across by 70cm high.

Free of diseases normally associated with Hebes. The leaves are narrow pale green and glossy with sprays of scented flowers borne in July & August. Good for bees.
